Most of you will not have heard of Joscelin Lowden, but she is/was one of the athletes I have coached for nearly 20 years, running for Sussex when she was a teenager as well as a senior in her mid-twenties. Unfortunately an injury forced her to stop running and so she took up cycling about 4 years ago. In 2017 she won the national hill climb championship and in the last 2 years has been riding for semi pro teams.

Well today was the highlight so far as she rode for Great Britain in the world champs in Harrogate as part of the mixed team [3 men 3 women] time trial. Starting 4th of the 11 teams Joscelin did a lot of hard work on the hilly first part of the 14km course and helped her team finish in 1st place and they stayed there until the last 2 teams finished [Germany and Holland] Holland winning Germany 2nd and GB gaining a fantastic Bronze Medal.

Although it's not track and field it's still the 2nd athlete I have coached that has competed for Great Britain after Rob Mullett.
