


SUSSEX COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS

SUSSEX COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS

HERBIE WINS THE MINITHON

Elizabeth Lawson, Miles Levy and Herbie Belfield all took part in the U13 Minithon at the Sussex County Champs. This consists of 3 events – a choice of a run (150m or 800m), a jump (long jump or high jump) and a throw (shot or discus). Results from each discipline are equated to points which are totalled at the end of the day and the athletes with the top 3 scores win gold, silver, bronze.

So many congratulations to Herbie Belfield - gold medallist in the boys competition - with winning performances in the 150m, long jump and shot put. Amazing stuff!





OSCAR BREAKS THE U15B 80M HURDLES RECORD

A super run from Oscar Fermor-McGhie saw him break a club record that has stood for 20 years! His time of 12.62 seconds, set at the Sussex County Championships, smashed Chris Piling's previous record of 12.7 seconds and earned him a silver medal. Many congratulations, Oscar!

LOUIS BREAKS THE U20 LONG JUMP RECORD

Another great performance at the Sussex County Championships saw Louis Williams jump a huge 6.20 metres to beat another one of Chris Pillings record of 6.04 metres (sorry Chris!) set in 2009. Louis also won a silver medal in the process so huge congratulations!

MEDALS AT THE SPRING WALK CHAMPIONSHIPS

PBs AT THE WORTHING 10K

Both got new PBs and came 3rd and 4th in the U20s, and 27th and 30th overall - with times of 35.28 and 35.30 respectively. Well done!

U13 SUSSEX LEAGUE - MATCH 1

At the first U13 Sussex AA League Match we had over 55 athletes competing and you certainly made us very proud. The night only stopped when we were forced to, because the lights went out at 9pm! Lewes as a team, came 2nd, behind Brighton and Hove AC. Many of you competed for the first time at a UK Athletics recognised competition and there were so many amazing individual results! Below are just a few of them:



- Herbie Belfield ran a super speedy 75m in 9.9 seconds, coming in 1st place; and was also 1st in the Shot Put with 7.43m!
- Miles Levy was 3rd overall in the boys with 21.1 secs in the 150m.
- Django White came 1st in the Long Jump with a good jump at 4.14m. Magnus Robins also had a great jump at 4.42m (non-scoring U13).
- Tamsin Bennett came 3rd in the 75m with very fast 11.5 secs.
- Felicity Frappell had a great evening coming 3rd in the hurdles at 14.2 secs and 3rd in the high jump at 1.15m.
- Mathilda Newman came 2nd in the long jump with a good 3.8m.
- Nancy Youniss came 3rd in the discus with a good distance of 12.04m.
- Milly Dennis had a super run in the 75m at 11.4 secs (U13 non-scoring).
- In the U11s boys, Herbie Hooker had a super run in the 75m at 11.7 secs, Archie Foster had a good 150m, running in 22.7 secs and Felix French ran well in the 600m, in 2.01 mins.
- In the U11 girls, Wrenn Cumber had a fast night, running the 75m 11.9 secs and the 600m in 2.04 mins.
- Our U13 boys and girls relay teams both came 2nd in the scoring relays, and we had 1sts and 2nds in the many non-scoring relays

U13 SUSSEX LEAGUE - MATCH 2

The second U13 Sussex AA League Match had fewer Lewes athletes but those who went did the team and themselves proud. Here are a few of the many great results:

Miles came second at 10.6secs in the 75m; Django came second in the 150m with 22.6 secs. There was a PB for Ralf in the 1000m (3.19mins). Felix French improved on his 600m time (1.56 mins) and Isaac Hosmer came with a very respectable 2.05 mins. Django and Miles won the A and B String Long Jumps. The Lewes boys came 3rd in the boys relay.



Lilja Elise Arif came 2nd in her 75m race with 11.6secs; Edie Clark came 3rd with 23 secs in the A string 150m race and ran the 75m in 11.2 secs (has since got a PB of 11 secs); Cecily Trotman 3rd in B String with 23.6 secs; Nelly Rowley-Terry got a PB in 600m (2.04mins); and the girls came 3rd in the relay.

In the U11s, Archie Foster had a brilliant 75m run at 11.3 secs, Herbie Hooker ran the 600m in 2.03mins; Elspeth Taylor had a great run in the 75m at 15 secs.




YOUTH DEVELOPMENT LEAGUE - UAG

URGENT: YOUR CHILD'S CLUB NEEDS YOU!

Across the county, athletics clubs are facing a crisis in not being able to supply enough officials and volunteers to hold meetings and events. This situation has been so severe in recent matches that, as a club, we have had to consider withdrawing from some competitions. Doing so would severely impact our junior athletes and of course the reputation of our club.

We're so very grateful to those who are officials and do regularly help out - however, we rely on the same few people all the time and we need LOTS more involvment from other parents to make this more sustainable. By having more volunteers, we can spread the workload!

So how can you help? Firstly, if you are signing your child up for a club-organised match (Sussex League, YDL, SAL), please do offer to help by emailing the team manager. Match volunteers are allocated to a field event for an hour or so and asked to help with things like raking sand, fetching javelins, checking wind speeds - and you can absoutely still watch your child's event whilst helping out. More hands make light work....

Secondly, you can become a fully accredited Official by completing a level 1 qualification online.

The training takes 4 hours to complete and Lewes AC will cover the cost. Once you've got your qualification, you can become a valued member of the officials team at Lewes, taking part in club and county competitions. Club officials don't pay their adult membership fees and parents receive a discount on their child's junior fees.

On the weekend of Saturday/Sunday 16/17th August 2025 starting at 12 pm Lewes AC will be hosting the National Long Distance Race Walk Championship: 100 Miles within 24 Hours.

My lead club, Surrey Walking Club, of which I have been a member since 1960 (!!) are the promoting body supported by the Centurions 1911 (a specialist organisation for those who have officially completed 100 Miles, within the 24 hour standard). This year will be the Centurions 1911 100th 100 Miles event. It also coincides with SWC's 125th Anniversary (the club was formed at the same time as the outbreak of the Anglo Boer War1899; Queen Victoria was still on the throne just, she died 2 years later).

Joining us will be a few of the athletes from abroad (Holland, Belgium and other countries will be taking part throughout the full 24 hours).

In addition to the main race and to celebrate the occasion, it is intended to include a 100 Lap Relay Challenge between a Junior Lewes AC Team (under 18), Centurions 1911 Team (mainly Masters /Veterans) and one or two other teams who may wish to participate such as one from older Lewes AC members. This event would start at 1pm on Saturday 16th August and use the outer three lanes of the track. The idea for the relay is that each athlete completes four laps allowing for 25 athletes per team.
